 - 2.1. The house was informed that the grant of Rs. 1 Crore has been utilised in accordance with specified components and heads of accounts (HOA) and Standard Objects of Expenditure (SOE). The bills have been submitted to the treasury as per guidelines of the Minister of Finance for closure of the financial year.
 - 2.2 All the classrooms and seminar halls have been ICT enabled as per resolution of IQAC. Hands on training has also been provided to all the staff members.
 - 2.3) In accordance with the IQAC resolution regarding starting of Coaching for IAS and HPAS, the bid was invited for providing free coaching within the College campus.

Nimbus Academy Chandigarh has emerged as the L1 bidder and the coaching shall start from 12th May 2022. It will have two batches of 60 students each. 3. The IQAC members were apprised that scholarships to students who listed in the merit of the advanced learners test to test the different levels of their learning were granted by Zeon Life Sciences Ltd. Paonta Sahib amounting to ₹ 3,32,500/- (Three Lakh Thirty Two Thousand Five Hundred only).

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Vivek Negi to all those present.




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

